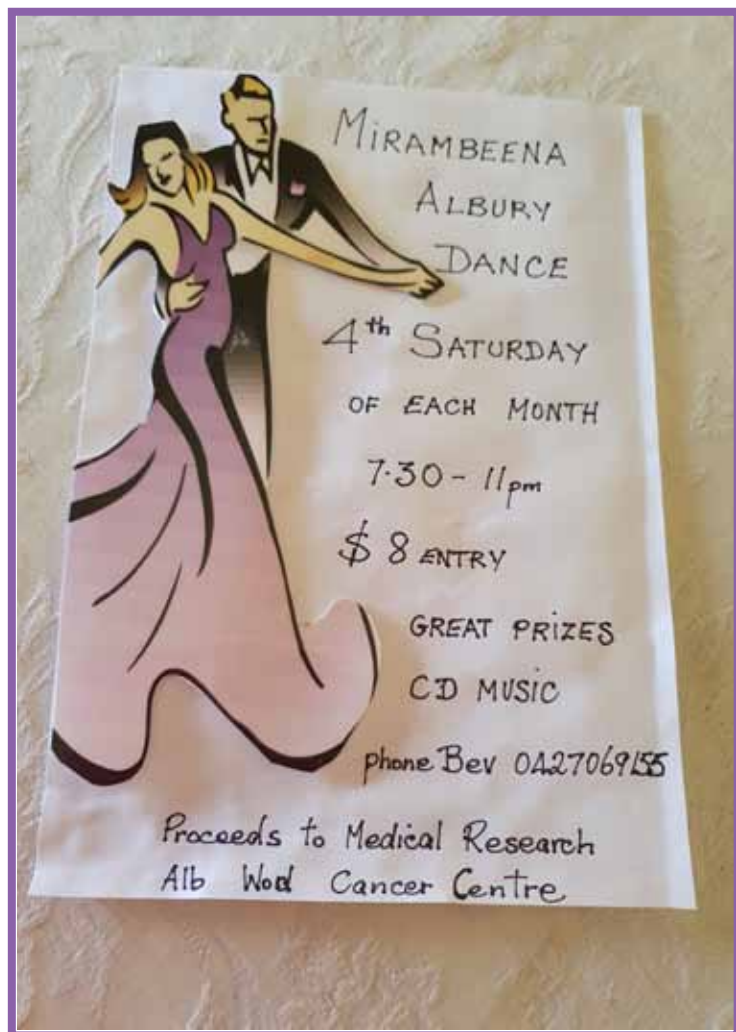

However, there are still many unknowns and possibilities so that we still need to be cautious and keep as safe as we can. It's quite strange that not having to wear a mask was something we all wanted, but now, as we are able to move around and mingle together, we can easily start to feel 'undressed' without one, we have some concerns about doing so. I guess the best we can do really is the best we can do. JW

### FUTURE DANCING AT KYNETON – ARE YOU INTERESTED?

Whilst the K&DOTDC is planning to continue to operate out of Lancefield Hall, Steve and I would really like to see dancing resume at Kyneton. It has been a long time Covid put a stop to being able to dance, due to the unavailability of St Mary's Hall. Now that K&DOTDC Committee has decided to continue to use Lancefield Hall, we felt that there were many loyal and enthusiastic dancers who may like to be able to dance again at Kyneton and we would see what we could do to make this happen.

If this is to happen, we need St Mary's Hall to be available. The good news is that just today I caught up with Fr O'Brien, the Parish priest, after having tried unsuccessfully for some weeks, if not months, to do so. We had a very amicable discussion. Now that Covid restrictions on dancing have been lifted, he is happy to allow dancing in the Hall again. I explained the situation re the Club relocating at this stage to Lancefield and that our venture would be quite separate from K&DOTDC, that we would be starting from scratch without too much experience in running regular dances. This dance would not, in any way, be in competition with Lancefield, but rather Kyneton could/would fill a gap that has opened up, largely since Covid struck – with the loss of local dances such as Trentham, Newstead, Majorca and others. In days past, the third Friday was always Kyneton Football Club, just as the second Friday was Trentham and alternate first Fridays were Newstead and Maldon. Kyneton dances catered for and were supported by many of from the north and west, as well as south and east, many of who now find that the distance to travel to Lancefield is too far. You have always been so loyal to Kyneton that, if it is possible, we would like to again provide dance events for you. Your regular attendance and enthusiasm went a long way towards making those pre-Covid dances such happy and friendly events.

Steve and I would really appreciate your feedback and input so we know whether this will be feasible/viable before we get started. Please email, phone or text (0400 126 870).

It would be wonderful to have dancing in Kyneton again.

Information from President Rod is that the K&DOTDC Committee has decided that K&DOTDC dances (Tuesday afternoons and Friday nights) will continue to be held at Lancefield, at least for the remainder of 2022 as the hall and bands have been booked ahead.

K&DOTDC Tuesday dancing will continue as usual from 1 -4pm at Lancefield. Tuesdays have been successful and well attended, with increasing numbers of dancers coming from the local and metro areas. Great effort!

Personally, and maybe on your behalf, I would like to acknowledge and thank both Mary Thornely for her efforts over the past several years as President, and Rod, who took over as Acting President during the past months. It was obviously a most difficult time to keep a dance club going when dancing was so often not permitted. I also want to sincerely thank Enid and Dick, both of whom have been such special and integral members of the club since its inception. They have been marvellous workers, who have contributed enormously to the club.
