Everyone on board again for a drive on the 90 miles beach, "what a magnificent view".


Now heading back to our home away from home with stop for ice creams and other necessities, arriving at our accommodation around 6.30 PM for dinner and a quite night.

Then it was aboard our flight to Melbourne and more goodbyes before collecting our cars and going our respective ways.


To all who came on our tour to New Zealand, it was good having you with us and we enjoyed your company immensely.
