Congratulations Bev

Just in cast you can't read the article, here it is in full.

WHEN Bev Grunow's marriage ended, dancing helped her make a fresh start. And for the past six years, she has been using her newfound passion to help others.

The 80 year old has been running ballroom sequence dances in Abury since 2017 helping people stay active and find new connections.

It's not only the local senior community she is helping; all proceeds from her weekly dances on Mondays and monthly Saturday evening dances go to charity.

To date, she has raised about \$70,000.00 for various causes, most of them local.

Bev took up dancing in 2002 after moving from Woomargama to Albury.

She sometimes found herself dancing up to five times a week.

"it was just a really nice form of entertainment, socialising and meeting people" she said.

'That was why I came to Albury: it's a bigger place and I thought it would be easier to get around and meet people"

Bev was so dedicated to dancing, people began asking if she would teach them.

So, she started a Monday class at St. Peter's Lutheran Hall in Lavington, with proceed going to the Albury Prostate Cancer Group. Demand soon outgrew the hall's capacity and the dance was moved to its current home of Mirambeena Community Hall.

Bev went on to start a monthly dance on Saturday evenings, with proceeds going to the Albury Wodonga Regional Cancer Centre.

Over the years, funds from the Monday dance have supported many local charities, including re-Start and children's cancer charity Country Hope.

Bev said that being charitable runs in her family - she grew up on a farm and her parents would often give milk and meat to families that could not afford them.



And it is not just the money raised that is helping others: she said the dances offer social connection and keep people active and healthy.

"We use every part of our body" she said.

"Dancing people who have a knee replacement are back on the dance floor in no time, because they are so agile and fit.

"We have one 99 - year old man who still lives alone, still cooks for himself, still drives, has two cars. To still be on the dance floor at that stage and living alone, is a great accomplishment".

It's not only seniors who are reaping rewards from the dances.

A group of 18 to 20 year olds have recently started attending the Saturday evening soirees.

"They come from beautiful families and after each dance is over, they always send a text message saying how lovely it was to be welcomed," Bev said.

other regulars travel from as far afield as Melbourne for he Saturday night dances. Bev attributes their popularity to the welcoming environment

"I just like them to have a lovely night " she said.

"I make the supper and everything as well.

"I Just think it's nice seeing everybody being so happy and smiling on the dance floor."

Bev encourages anyone in the area who is looking for a way to stay active and make new social connections to attend a dance and give it a try.

"Its really hard for the first time going somewhere people just need that little push to get them there." Monday dances take place from 3.30 - 6.00pm weekly and entry is \$5.

Sturday dances run from 7 - 10.30pm on the fourth Saturday of each month. Entry is \$8.00 plus \$2 for a raffle ticket.



The bus trip was a very scenic one with mountains on the right side and the Pacific Ocean on the other side.




A welcome stop was "the store café" where we all had a delicious morning tea and walk around the beach gardens.


